

PBIS REWARDS 2016-2017

As our students continue to demonstrate proper behaviors in school, please note that the reward system has been updated to reflect the growing number of achievers. Please also note the individual reward list at the bottom of the page. We will also only read names at our quarterly assemblies (February, April and May).

- Reward System
 - Staff member issues GATOR points when student displays desired GATOR behavior
 - Every 40 GATOR points = Name card goes on the GATOR wall
 - Every 80 GATOR points = White Ribbon
 - Every 120 GATOR POINTS = Name on PBIS school webpage and
 - Yellow Ribbon
 - Choose from the menu of rewards (Tier I)
 - Every 160 GATOR POINTS = Shoutout at monthly assembly
 - Name in Quarterly newsletter and
 - Blue Ribbon and
 - Choose from the menu of rewards (Tier I or II)
 - Every 200 GATOR POINTS = Award Certificate and
 - Choose from the menu of rewards (Tier I, II or III)
 - Students will get to choose from the menu of rewards for every 50 additional tickets they earn

Rewards for Individual Elementary Level Students

Tier I

- Assist the custodian for 20 minutes during your recess
- Assist Coach Mangrum, Coach Tagent or Mr. Jonathan for 20 minutes during your recess
- Help in a lower grade level class during your recess
- Be your teacher's helper for the day
- Be the first one in the lunch or snack line
- Have the teacher or principal make a positive phone call home

Tier II

- Assist with morning announcements over the PA system
- Eat with a friend in the classroom or office (with the teacher or principal)
- Eat lunch with a friend in Mrs. DEE DEE's office
- Be a Guest Reader to another class.

Tier III

- Get a "no homework" pass
- 15 minutes of free time
- Work as the Principal apprentice for 20 minutes
- Be a Guest Reader to another.

Lunch/Recess Challenge

- Lunchroom Behavior System
 - Each class can earn up to 5 points daily
 - 1 point for lunch line
 - 1 point for table behavior (noise/movement)
 - 1 point for cleared table
 - 1 point for recess behavior
 - 1 point for dismissal behavior
 - Points are tabulated every Friday
 - After tallying the points:
 - Classes are designated as either Blue (24-25 points) or Gold (20-23 points) Ribbon winners for the following week
 - They receive either Blue or Gold ribbon for their classroom door
 - They get to line up for lunch first and choose play area
- Redefined play area with Monitor supervision
 - Soccer
 - Basketball
 - Relay Racing
 - Jump Rope
 - Peaceful Playground

Hallway Challenge

- Focus for this year will be on Hallway Behavior
 - We will ask teachers to create a tally chart and tally each time their class receives a compliment in the hallway. If they receive 10-15 tallies, they will receive a gold sneaker. If they receive 16-20, they will receive a blue sneaker.

This will be an extension of the Blue and Gold Ribbon Cafeteria theme and classes that receive consistent blue sneakers will receive Shoutouts on our weekly announcements and Monthly Assemblies.
